

Authors' Guide to *Kansas English*

Kansas English, published by the Kansas Association of Teachers of English, welcomes manuscripts contributing to understanding and scholarship in all areas of English/Language Arts, including curriculum design, pedagogy, classroom action research, and literature reviews.

This journal invites writers to focus on a broad range of topics: reading and writing connections, audience, motivation, engagement, collaboration, assessment, technology, critical thinking, discourse, rhetoric, multiculturalism, community-classroom connections, policy, and reflection. Nontraditional, creative pieces (such as personal narratives and poetry) are also encouraged.

All manuscripts should be typed (with text in Times New Roman 12-point font), double-spaced, numbered according to page, and conform to current MLA or APA guidelines.

Save work as Word for Windows or RTF format. No identifying information should appear in the manuscript. Include a separate cover letter with your name, address, telephone number, email address, and school affiliation.

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
